The June Dairy Days Committee is planning to hold June Dairy Days on June 4, 5, and 6 this year. More information will follow.


Facebook Promotion



We are pleased to see the much needed rain in the Coulee Region as long as it decides to stay dry for June Dairy Days weekend.

We were due a post here to update our dedicated followers on information about June Dairy Days for this year. Here are some FAQs we have been seeing and hearing:

Will there be a beer tent this year?

• YES! And we are so excited to be offering the same group of volunteers to be working this area and many beverage choices. With that being said, there will be changes to the beer tent area. We recognize that people may want to socially distance and we want to accommodate that. We will be removing the fenced in area around the beer tent and adding more picnic tables on the outskirts of the tent for those that want to distance from the crowd in front of the band and the beer tent area. We will require IDs to purchase beer tickets.

Will we still have Bands and Fireworks?

• Yes. Bands have been booked and we will be adding the Facebook events this weekend so everyone can block this time off on their calendar. Fireworks will also be taking place Friday night per tradition.

Will buttons be required?

• No. We want to see as many people as possible at June Dairy Days and since we are removing the fence to allow for social distancing, there was no way to monitor those with buttons. However, we will have buttons available for purchase if people want them as souvenirs or as a donation to June Dairy Days.

Will there still be a parade?

• We are happy to report that there is. We will have registration for parade participants on our website soon and have selected our Parade Marshall.

Will there be a carnival?

• Yes. We have been advised by the carnival organizers that they are required to abide by CDC guidelines and their employees will be wearing masks.

Will we require masks at the parade or park?

• No. We recommend masks but will not be requiring people to wear them.

Will there be food available at the park?

• Yes. We will have many different food vendors to choose from and our Dairy folks will be back with ice cream. The Legion will also be having their famous Chicken Que. June Dairy Days however, will not be serving their own food for this year.

Will June Dairy Days extend to Sunday?

• Yes but in a limited capacity? We will still be having the car show on Leonard Street and the Chicken Que and Bingo will be taking place in the park but we will not have other activities during the day at the park.

Please reach out to us with any questions that you may still have. We are very excited that we will be able to have this event back this year and want to kick off the festival season in style. We have been working closely with other festivals in the area as well as

the organizers of Country Boom to ensure that we are providing the safest events possible for all that chose to attend.
