

Downtown Trick-or-Treating is fast approaching. Downtown Trick-or-Treating will be held on Monday, October 31 from 3:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m.

Every year our numbers have gone up. This year we are anticipating over 1,000 children. That is at least 500 adults who get exposed to your business.

We distribute signs the morning of October 31 to all of the participating businesses welcoming the Trick-or-Treaters in, and when you are done or out of candy treats, simply pull your sign out of your window.

As the temperature starts to drop and autumn officially starts, the West Salem Parks and Recreation Department is excited to buckle down and begin planning our 2022 Special Events for the Village of West Salem. This year, we have two major community projects taking place. The first is our tenth annual Trunk-Or-Treat event. The second is our ninth annual Winter Wonderland in Village Park. Below you can find a brief description of both of these events, along with ways for you to partner with us to make them the best they can be for our community.

Lynxx NetworksSM Bringing Fiber Broadband Services to West Salem

Camp Douglas, Wisconsin – Lynxx NetworksSM is bringing its high-speed, fiber-optic internet, voice, and TV services to residential and business customers throughout the Village of West Salem.

The company has had fiber to select locations in West Salem since 2015, where it started with services to Allied Cooperative and the Lakeview Business Park. Since then, Lynxx NetworksSM has expanded its network 16 miles in the village and has invested \$1.8 million worth of fiber infrastructure in the community.

"We started off serving only business customers, but have already begun to serve residential customers in the new housing developments located near the Lakeview Health Center, which is also on our network," said Lynxx NetworksSM CEO Jim Costello.

Costello said the company's mainline fiber network extends down Highway 16 from the far east side of the village to the far west side and includes the businesses along the south side of the I-90 corridor. Approximately 40 businesses in the village are currently Lynxx NetworksSM customers, including the West Salem School District, the Village offices and Police Department, Vermeer, and Brickl Brothers.

West Salem is also home to Lynxx NetworksSM wholly-owned subsidiaries, 3RT Networks and Bahr Electric.

"Between our business presence and the amount of fiber that's already in place, it makes sense to now bring fiber internet services to the entire community," Costello said.

This expansion will bring multi-gigabit internet speeds to the Village of West Salem.

The Village has entered into a fiber deployment collaboration agreement with Lynxx NetworksSM for the project. The agreement will assist with promotion and deployment of the fiber network.

"We are excited to be able to work with Lynxx NetworksSM to give our residents and businesses multi-gigabit services," said Village Administrator Teresa DeLong.

Gov. Evers Announces Additional \$25 Million Investment into Successful Main Street Bounceback Program, Grants Have Already Supported Over 6,000 Businesses & Nonprofits



Gov. Tony Evers recently announced that <u>an additional \$25 million</u> will be invested into the Main Street Bounceback Grant Program, bringing the governor's total investment into the program to \$100 million.

Gov. Evers' Main Street Bounceback program, which provides \$10,000 to recipients to help them move or expand into vacant commercial spaces, has now supported more than 6,000 small businesses and nonprofits in communities in all 72 counties in Wisconsin. The deadline to apply for a Main Street Bounceback Grant has been extended to December 31, 2022. Grants

will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis until all the funds are disbursed.

Grant funds are available as part of the American Recovery Plan Act (ARPA) and distributed by the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) <u>regional partners</u>. Businesses must apply through the partner organization for the region in which they are located. The program is open to new or existing businesses opening a new location or expanding operations in a vacant commercial property where the lease commences, or sales contract closes, on or after January 1, 2021 and on or before December 31, 2022.


